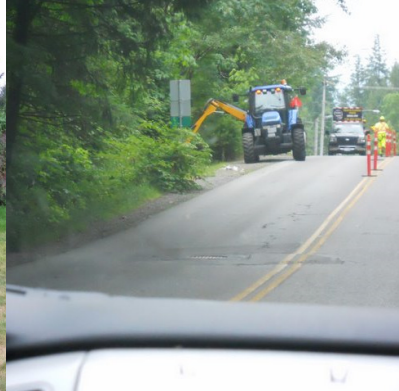




Invasive Species Training
